

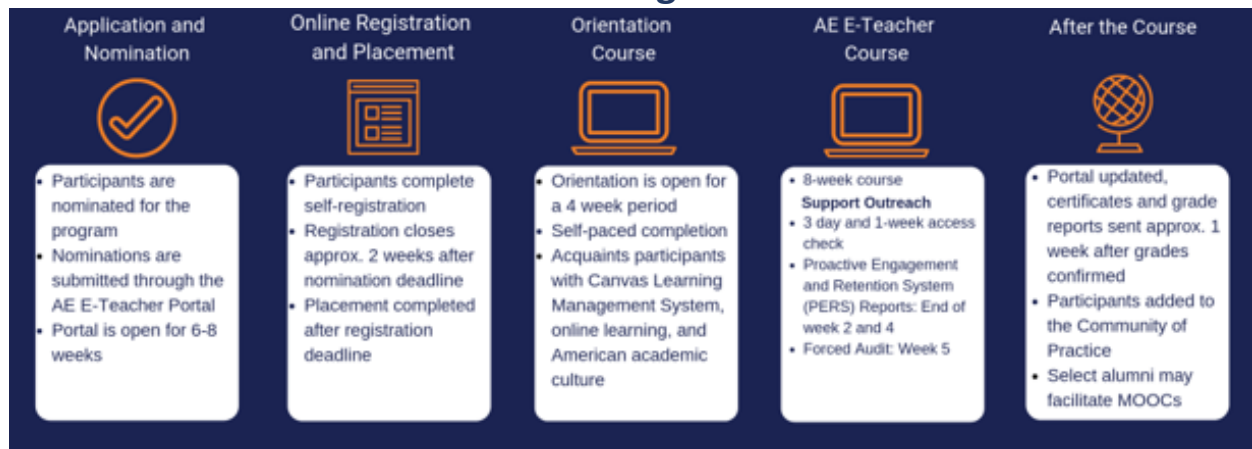

AY 18-19 (Winter, Spring and Summer) Global Online Course Updates

The AE E-Teacher Program is pleased to share this information about Winter, Spring and Summer 2019 Global Online Courses (GOCs) including schedules, support activities, and program contact information. As a reminder, below is the overall timeline of an AE E-Teacher Global term.

Winter 2019

The Winter Term started on January 8, 2019. We recently processed the second PERS report and changed a total of 20 participants (4%) to Audit status. 29 participants were reported at risk of failing, a decrease of 3% from the fall term.

Grades, Certificates and Badging

FHI 360 updates portal records after grades are confirmed and creates reports which are sent directly to participants. Approximately one week after the grade confirmation due date, you can access the portal to view grades. If you need help, please contact ae-eteachertech@fhi360.org. All certificates are sent to posts for distribution. FHI 360 distributes digital badges directly to successful course completers. Badges are portable tokens of achievement which also contain information about the knowledge gained in the process of completing the course. Participants can share badges to social media profiles such as Facebook or LinkedIn. Encourage participants to post on social media tagging **@AmericanEnglishforEducators** and using the hashtags **#AmericanEnglish** and/or **#AEforEducators** so that we can find their posts and share them more broadly with the AE E-Teacher alumni community.
